Purpose

FTCC uses Panopto with Canvas. Faculty can manage course-folder videos, embed videos in Canvas content, and provide student video access without Canvas Studio.

Steps

1. Open the Panopto course tool and confirm the correct course folder.
2. Record with the enabled Panopto recorder or upload an existing supported file.
3. Use a clear title and organize the video in the intended course folder.
4. Review sharing so enrolled students have viewer access.
5. Generate or add captions and review them for accuracy.
6. Embed the video through the Rich Content Editor or add a Panopto link in the intended module.
7. Use Student View or an appropriate test to confirm playback and access.

Watch For

- The exact Panopto tool name can vary by local configuration.
- A video can exist in Panopto but still be inaccessible because of folder or sharing permissions.
- Automatic captions require human review.
